Art of kintsugi :- Embracing the imperfect

All the things are created and destined to be broken. Being broken or imperfect is not a bad thing as it leads to something beautiful. Japanese philosophy, Zen Buddhist approached to ceramics and developed an argument that pots, cups and bowls that had become damaged shouldn't simply be neglected or thrown away. They should continue to attract our respect and attention and be repaired with enormous love and care. The word given to this tradition of ceramics repair is Kintsugi.

Kintsugi is derived from the word 'kin' which means 'golden' and tsugi' means 'joinery'. Simply, it means 'to join with gold'. It is believed to be originated from Murom chin period. Where the shogun of Japan Ashikaga Yoshimitsu broke his favorite tea bowl. At last, he ended with Art of Kintsugi which does not disguise the damage but made something properly careful out of it. The care and love of Ashikaga Yashimitu towards his tea bowl teaches all of us to the confidence, to respect what is damage and scarred, vulnerable and imperfect by starring with ourselves and those around us.

The broken ceramics are put together again, the cracks are filled with gold and cement to tell all of us that broken can be beautiful again. The art Kintsugi restores broken things with lacquer cracks which are covered with gold to transform the plot into a special object. The glue by which the lacquer cracks are attached together is generated from Japan's sap of an indigenous tree. Instead of covering up the laws art of Kintsugi beautifies the breakage which attracts many peoples heart.

The restored ceramic becomes a symbol of fragility, strength and beauty. It teaches us resilience and helps us to put together the fragment of ourselves. It helps us to restore both physical and emotional pains and tells us to never give up. The Eastern philosophy 'wabi-sabi' finds beauty in imperfection. So, we should see Kintsugi as a powerful metaphor of life where nothing is truly broken.
